## DISCONTINUATION OF FREE SCHOOL MEALS

The federal funding for free school meals ended in June. This school year, our meals are regular price. Because the income guidelines change each year, ALL families are encouraged to submit the Free/Reduced Application.

Our cooks continue to provide delicious and nutritious meals for our students. Each year new items are tried on the menu and offered on ala carte.

Remember, that all items outside of the full meal are an extra cost. This includes extra entrée items and all ala carte items.

# ELEMENTARY CAR RIDERS

## Preschool Arrival/Dismissal

To ensure the safety of our littlest lions, preschool students will be dropped off and picked up at the exterior entrance of their preschool classroom. Parents should park in the parking lot labeled preschool parking and walk their students across to the entrance marked preschool drop off and pick up. Please be mindful of the traffic within the parking lot. A staff member will be there to greet you and your child.

## K-5 Morning Car Riders

Parents that are dropping their students off in the morning, should follow the traffic flow. There will be signs the first few weeks of school conveying which direction to go. **It is extremely important that our families follow the traffic flow as it prevents our line from blocking buses and backing up to 771.** If you are the first car, please pull to the very end of the sidewalk, at the end of the building. Parents/guardians are asked to remain in your vehicle and allow the students to exit on the curbside. Staff members will be on duty beginning at 8:15. Do not send students to the building until you see a staff member. If you need to park and go to the elementary office, please use the crosswalk. **Drivers, please be mindful of families who may be parking and entering the preschool entrance and/or the elementary entrance.**

## K-5 Afternoon Car Riders

Transportation changes must be made through the school office with a 24 hour notice including parent pick-up unless it is an emergency. All children will be dismissed at the end of the day outside to the appropriate mode of transportation. Students who are being picked up by a parent/guardian will be dismissed from their classroom to the designated indoor waiting area. Parents/guardians should park in the back parking lot, form an orderly line outside on the sidewalk, have their form of I.D. readily available and the assigned teacher will work through the line to dismiss students. No child will be allowed to enter the parking area unattended. There will no longer be inside pick up at the end of the day.

# FINALFORMS

If you are a parent or guardian of a Fairfield student, by now you have probably heard of FinalForms. This summer, we rolled out this on-line student registration platform. All student registration forms and documents will now be managed through FinalForms.

## FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS AND PURCHASES

The summer is always a busy time for schools trying to address the needs of new buses, facility cleaning, maintenance and repairs as well as completing major facility projects. Fairfield is working on several projects as listed below:

### PAVING

The Soccer and Track complex parking lot will be paved in July. The lot will be expanded to provide over 20 new additional parking spots.

We are also resurfacing the drive lane in front of the gym as well as a few other select locations around the campus.

### FIBER OPTIC

We are installing new fiber optic lines connecting the Soccer/Track complex with the rest of the district.

### STORAGE BARN

Our district has a need for additional storage space not only for our academic and cleaning supplies but also for our athletic equipment. A new storage barn will be erected near the current Agricultural barn near the Soccer/Track complex. This new facility will allow us to move athletic equipment currently located in the Soccer/Track fieldhouse out and to create a larger weight training room in the fieldhouse.

### BUSES

The district received a large grant (\$180,000) to put toward the purchase of new buses. The district had planned to buy one new bus but with this grant we have ordered 3 which should arrive as school begins.

No debt was issued to pay for these improvements and purchases.
